# Living Lab Zagreb, Croatia

### **NBS** description

This NBS connects the current Sesvete centre and the existing Jelkovec housing development of 11.000 people. A 850-meter-long green corridor was proposed running along the planned street no. 6, including a cycling path. Before implementation it emerged that the street will not be built during proGlreg project's duration.

Instead, a cycling and pedestrian path has been implemented across the Living Lab in east-west direction. The path transforms the unsafe access to the former meat processing into a well-planned connection. Trees have been plannted along part of the path. Following the approval of the District council, the cycling path was built and finished in September 2023.

#### Aim & goals

The NBS addresses societal and environmental issues:

- Provides fast and safe pedestrian and cycling connection of previously disconnected areas
- Opens the area of the former industry site to the public
- Contributes to an integral pedestrian and cycling network within the larger area
- Encourage citizens of all age groups to engage in a more active lifestyle

# Target groups (beneficiaries)

Residents of Sesvete and Jelkovec housing, notably young and active and may also appeal to other age groups to activities outdoors.
